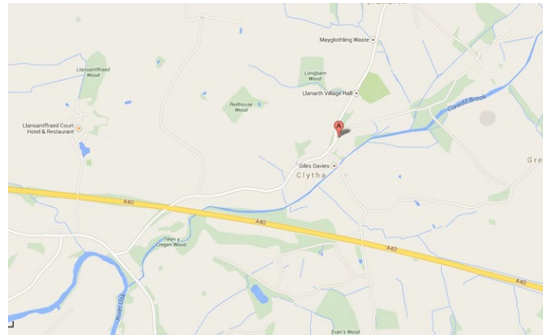

You will meet members of the team during visits, telephone contact and during your care planning meetings called CTPs/CPAs.

Please note we will not be able to discuss your relative, due to confidentiality, without the prior consent of your relative and staff may wish to gain permission prior to any contact. If you would like to speak to Dr Jones, the Responsible Clinician, or any other members of the team you can arrange this by contacting us.
