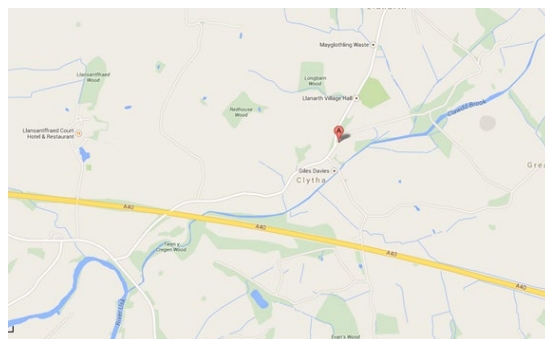

Ward philosophy

Deri low secure service will provide expert, supportive, individualised care for those whose psychiatric condition requires treatment in conditions of security. The service will provide a therapeutic focus on rehabilitation and social inclusion. Every patient's clinical management will depend upon thorough and continuous assessment of risk and holistic assessment of need encompassing the recovery approach in conjunction with the Tidal Model.

The aim of our service is to help patients to recover sufficiently to start working towards their own goals and recovery in order to start living a more independent life through rehabilitation. Moving on to less restrictive environments or into the community via care pathways identified by the CPA /CTP process.

This will be promoted within an environment where therapeutic relationships between staff and patients is enhanced being built on mutual trust, respect, warmth and empathy.

Visiting times and procedure

Prior to visiting your relative/friend you will be contacted by the social worker of the ward in order to approve you as a visitor.

Once you have been approved you will be able to contact the ward and arrange a mutually convenient time to visit your relative/friend. We discourage visits within patients' session time between 09:30-15:30 Monday to Friday. However, on the weekends visits can be arranged between 11:00-18:30 hours and 15:30-18:30 weekdays.

You will be required to sign in at reception Mon-Fri leaving all prohibited and restricted items in a designated locker. You will be unable to enter the ward without a visitors pass. Out of normal office hours you will be required to utilize the lockers provided on the ward.

Children are not allowed into the hospital unless you have gone through the child visiting process, likewise they are not to be left in the car whilst a visit is taking place. Please discuss any issues with the above with a member of staff.
