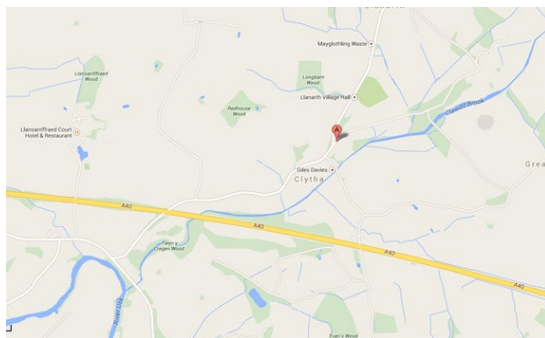

Ward philosophy

The unit offers a high quality, low secure service for male patients with a mental disorder. The unit employs a model of care which looks at maximising the strengths of patients whilst addressing the problem areas in their lives.

There is a dedicated multidisciplinary team (MDT), which promotes collaborative working with patients to achieve their goals and to address their risk behaviours, which will allow them to leave the secure unit.
